

## Student individual supply list for all art levels: Mrs. Bailey's art class

### Art 1

Wooden no. 2 school pencil

Mechanical pencil

Set of drawing pencils: at least a No. 4H and a No. 4B and a No. 6B (Check with your school to see if they supply these pencils.)

Pink or white eraser - large

Ruler

Compass: metal or plastic compass with a pencil

Set of colored pencils.

9 x 12 sketchbook. (Check to see if your school will get this for you – if not – you must have a sketchbook of your own.)

Black ink pens

Black sharpie markers – fine point

1- Student drawing/painting board-Optional - A board to tape work to. You can get a large form core board from Hobby lobby for \$6.00 per sheet. This can be cut in half with a knife. Price per student is then \$3.00 a piece. Only one is needed per student. I use a hardboard that is 2 feet by 2 feet square. It comes to about \$1.50 per student. I get it at a lumber yard. I call ahead to make sure they have some cut. (I use the hardboard as it lasts longer than foam core – doesn't dent. The work is taped down with masking tape to keep it flat during drawing or painting.) Only one board is needed per student.

### Art 2 through Art 4

You should have all of the supplies listed for Art 1 plus:

18 x 24 watercolor paper pad. This pad should have at least twelve sheets of paper for your large projects.
