Course Descriptions

- **Drawing** (02025) This class would teach students different supports used in drawing; overview of ways that drawing has been utilized, past and present; great artists who used or use drawing as their main way of communication. Students will also learn ways to achieve textural effects, depth, and proportions. Students will be taught how to use art as a way to communicate personal feelings and emotions through the use of pencil, ink, conte, pastel, markers, and more.
- Color and Design (02022) This class would concentrate on the development and use of color in art. Color harmonies, theories of balance, and design combinations would be taught. Styles uses from various cultures would be included. Materials being used would include colored pencil, ink, chalk and oil pastel, acrylic and tempera paint, colored wire and fabric, and a variety of glazes. Students will be able to utilize what they learn for use in other classes such as computers and FACS. Prerequisite: Art I
- Fundamentals of Art/Art (02021) This class would teach students the basic concepts of art and practice in utilization of the basic materials. I would include drawing, painting, composition, and crafts to allow for students to experience a number of mediums and techniques.

Letter to all schools

Each student will need to have a writing instrument and a 3-ring binder with paper each class period. The binder is necessary as students will frequently receive handouts which will be needed for the entire semester. They will also need access to all the supplies on the supply list each day.

I will collect normal assignments and projects from all distant sites on Friday's. I ask that tests and quizzes be mailed off the day they are completed. Faxing these in is also acceptable.

We will do some critiquing over the ITV system during class, but I do ask that these projects be mailed in on Friday as well for grading purposes.

I post grades using PowerSchool where possible as most schools are using this system currently. In order to do this I request to be setup with an account in each school. This is the quickest and easiest way to enter grades for both myself as well as the distant sites.

I would also like to request that each distant site send a copy of their school calendars. This makes it possible for myself to plan around days when many students will be absent or when a school is not in session. It is also easier for students to not miss demonstrations or notes.

Supplies

It is crucial that the supplies each student has are the ones given on the supply list. This ensures that all projects can be done in the same manner and that they can be turned in on time. I ask that the schools order the supplies and if nessecary make a kit for each student in the class rather than let the students buy things independently. There are many different types of each supply – the ones selected and requested are longer lasting and more economical for the classroom setting. They are also much more environmentally friendly, as the ITV classrooms are generally smaller in size.

It is also important as different brands or types need to be applied and cleaned up differently. I ask that the schools take the extra time to order the supplies requested.

Classrooms should also have a pencil sharpener, rulers 18" or longer (preferably metal), masking and scotch tape, a stapler with staples, paper towels, and a source of water as it states in the introduction letter. The students will be needing these supplies on a regular basis.
